WESTERN CATHOLICS:

Callistus I (3rd cent.), pope and martyr (Roman and Ambrosian calendars)

COPTS AND ETHIOPIANS (4 babah/teqemt):

Bacchus (d. ca. 300), companion of Sergius, martyr (Coptic Church)

Abreha and Asbeha (4th cent.), king of Axum (Ethiopian Church)

LUTHERANS:

James the Notary (d. ca. 430), martyr in Persia

MARONITES:

Gervasius and Protasius (3rd cent.), martyrs

Callistus I, pope

ORTHODOX CHRISTIANS AND GREEK CATHOLICS:

Nazarius, Gervasius, Protasius and Celsus of Milan, martyrs

Cosmas of Maiuma (d. 760), hymn writer

Paraskeve the Younger (10th cent.), nun (Romanian Church)

Abiatar, priest, and *Sidonia* (4th cent.)

Mirian III (4th cent.), king of Georgia, and *Nana his wife* (Georgian Church)
