COPTS AND ETHIOPIANS (19 misra/nahasse):

*Return to Scetis of the body of Macarius the Great* (Coptic Church)

LUTHERANS:

*Gregory of Utrecht* (d. 775), evangelist in Friesland

MARONITES:

*Titus of Gortina* (1st cent.), martyr

*Louis*, king of France

ORTHODOX CHRISTIANS AND GREEK CATHOLICS:

*Relocation of the relics of Bartholomew*, apostle

*Titus*, bishop of Gortina, apostle
